1. CALL TO ORDER:

President Nick Nicholson called the dinner meeting to order at 6:55 p.m. on the above date at the Hurlburt Officers Club

Mayor Montague made welcoming comments and introduced the guest sponsors for the nights meal and festivities and also introduced those present from the Town of Shalimar.

Each municipality was recognized and a representative from each introduced those in attendance from their respective Cities.

8. GUEST SPEAKER - Bernadette Cover:

Superintendent of Schools Bernadette Cover was the guest speaker.

Mrs. Cover gave an overview of the upcoming school year budget, by municipalities. She briefly explained what, where and how the funds would be spent in each school district.

Mrs. Cover noted that the Okaloosa County School Board had agreed to attempt a 1 Cent Sales Tax. She further explained that this could be accomplished only by the full cooperation of all municipalities within Okaloosa County. Each municipality would be required to turn it's share of the 1 Cent Sales Tax over to the School Board for a period of four years, she explained. This would enable the School system to build 3 new schools and do renovations on nearly all the other school facilities, Cover said.

In closing Mrs. Cover asked the League and its member municipalities to consider pledging their portions of the 1 Cent Sales Tax to the Okaloosa County School System.
