

**MINUTES OF THE OKALOOSA COUNTY  
LEAGUE OF CITIES  
QUARTERLY FALL DINNER MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 28, 2000**

**CALL TO ORDER** The fall dinner meeting was held at Glenda's Hobo Café, Highway 85 North, in Laurel Hill beginning at 7pm.
