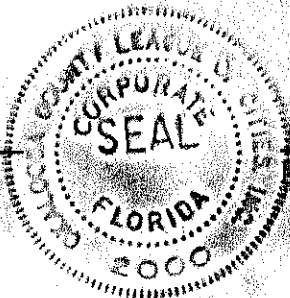
ENTERTAINMENT:
